



APPLICATION FOR JEEP CLUB SA RADIO LICENSE, PROCEDURES, TERMS & CONDITIONS

Terms and Conditions:

The Jeep Club SA NPC grants you, as a fully paid up member of Jeep Club SA, authorisation to operate your VHF radio on the Jeep Club SA frequencies, provided that:

1. Your membership to the Jeep Club SA is fully paid up and valid for the current membership year.
2. Your VHF radio type must be approved by ICASA for operation (Radio must have an ICASA approval sticker). You are obliged to advise the Jeep Club SA of Make and Model number of your radio/s, serial numbers included.
3. The license authorisation is not transferable if/when you sell either your vehicle or the radio. The Jeep Club SA Treasurer (accounts@jeepclubsa.co.za) should be advised of this in writing. The VHF permit is issued in your name only, in accordance with ICASA regulations. <https://www.icasa.org.za>. Please refer to the ICASA legislation/act as part of the terms and conditions: ***"Issued in terms of the Electronic Communications Act, 2005 (Act No. 36 of 2005) and the Radio Regulations currently in force."***
4. The Jeep Club SA does not currently charge any fees for the Jeep Club SA frequency, but reserves the right to do so should ICASA adjust the Jeep Club SA annual license fees at any time in the future. Your membership of the Jeep Club SA must at all times be fully paid up in order to validate the VHF permit.
5. It should be realised that the Jeep Club SA frequencies allocated to us by ICASA are not unique to us as a Club and there may well be other co-users sharing the frequency. Please respect this at all times.
6. The Jeep Club SA frequency is for the benefit of the Jeep Club SA and its members only and not to general forum members. Anyone having a two-way radio is encouraged to join the club and benefit from this privilege. The Jeep Club SA frequencies are valid only within the borders of South Africa and not the surrounding states.
7. The Jeep Club SA radio frequencies are intended for bona-fides Jeep Club SA members only and may not be used for any means of Business communication, for which you require your own private license.

8. By completing, signing and returning the Jeep Club SA Radio application form, you agree that you understand and will abide by all the Terms & Conditions noted above.
